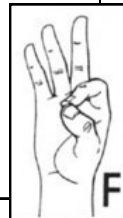

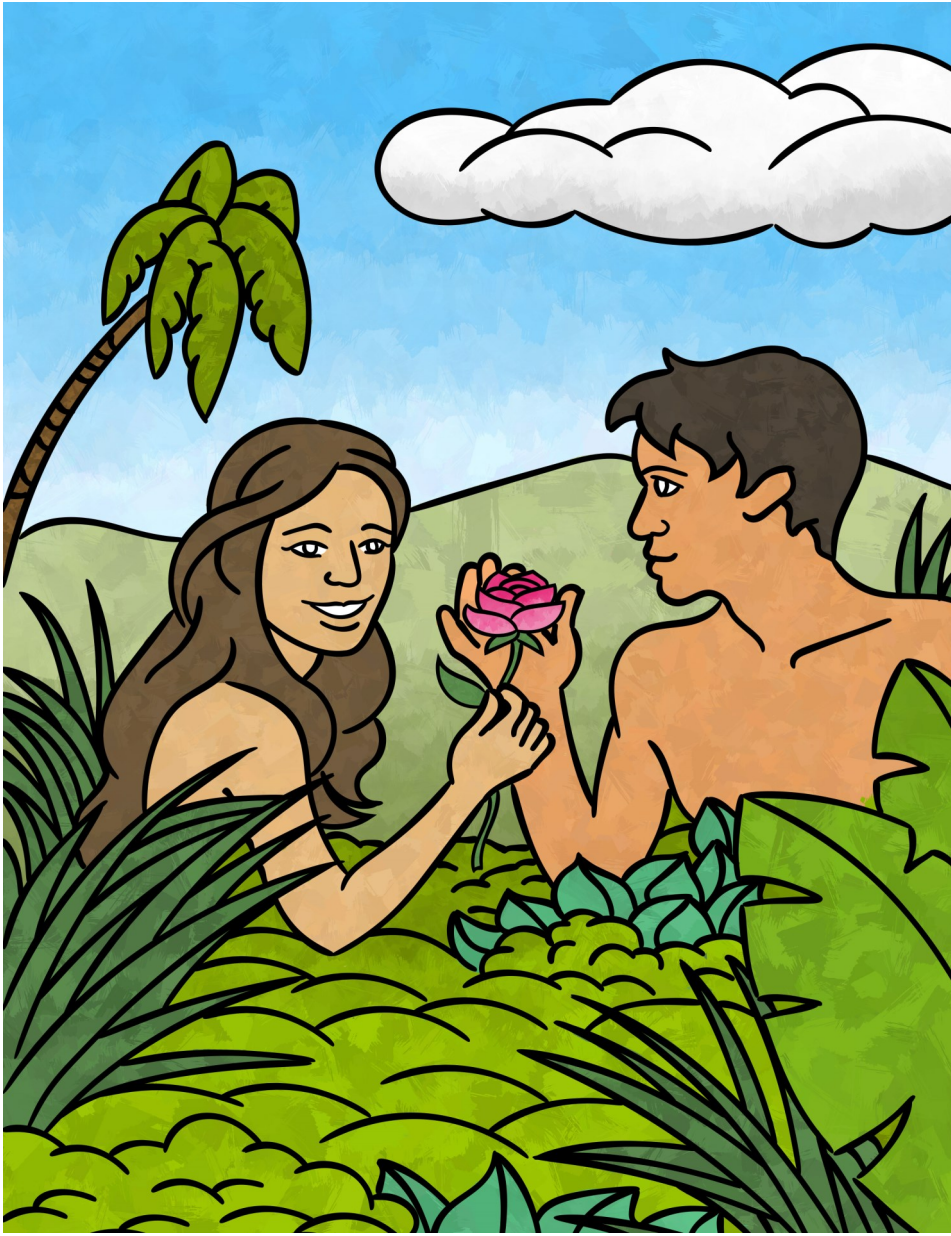

What they did is called the Fall.

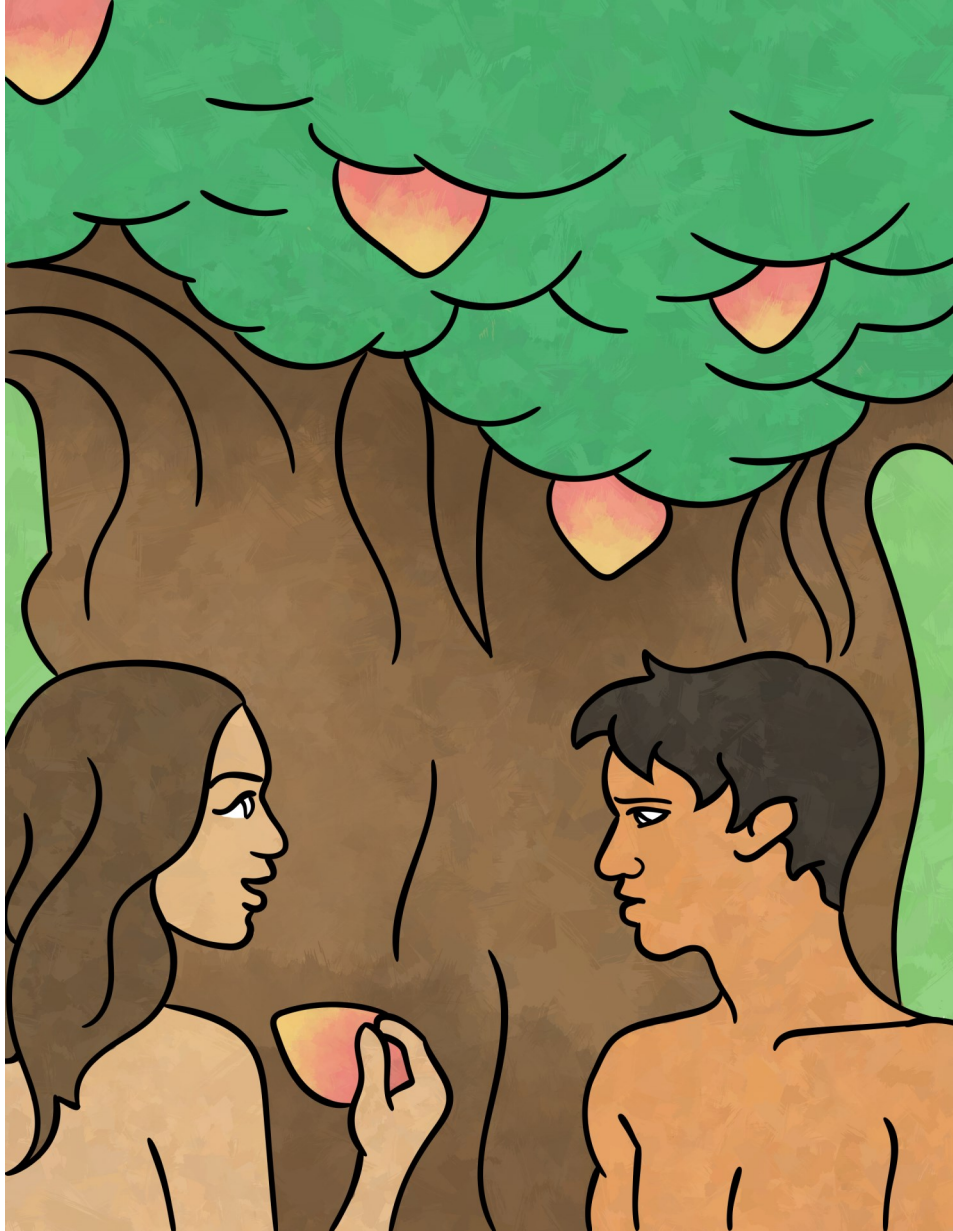
It means that everyone has sin.
