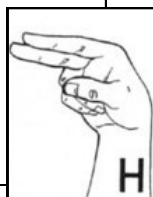

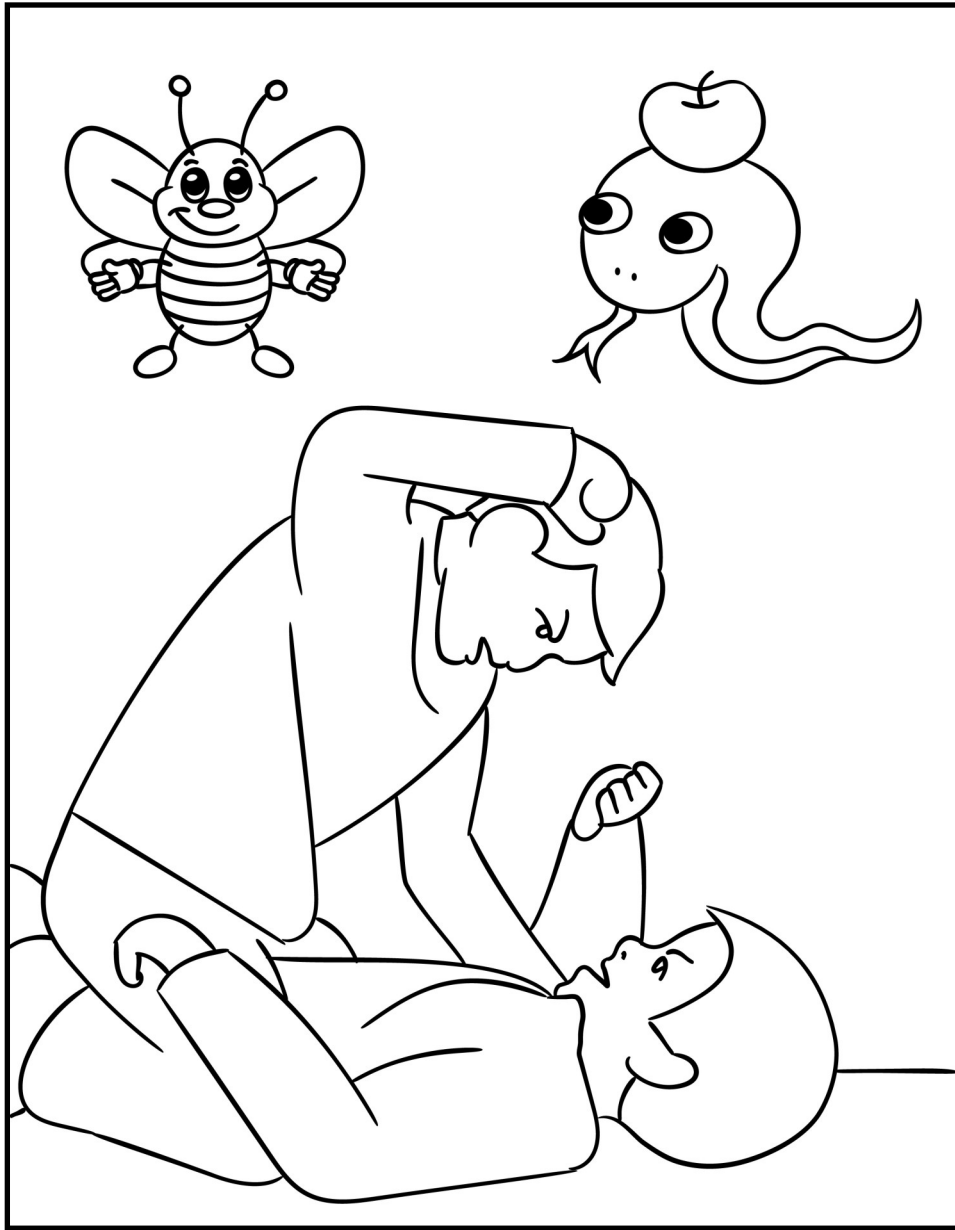

saying, "Here's the Son I love."



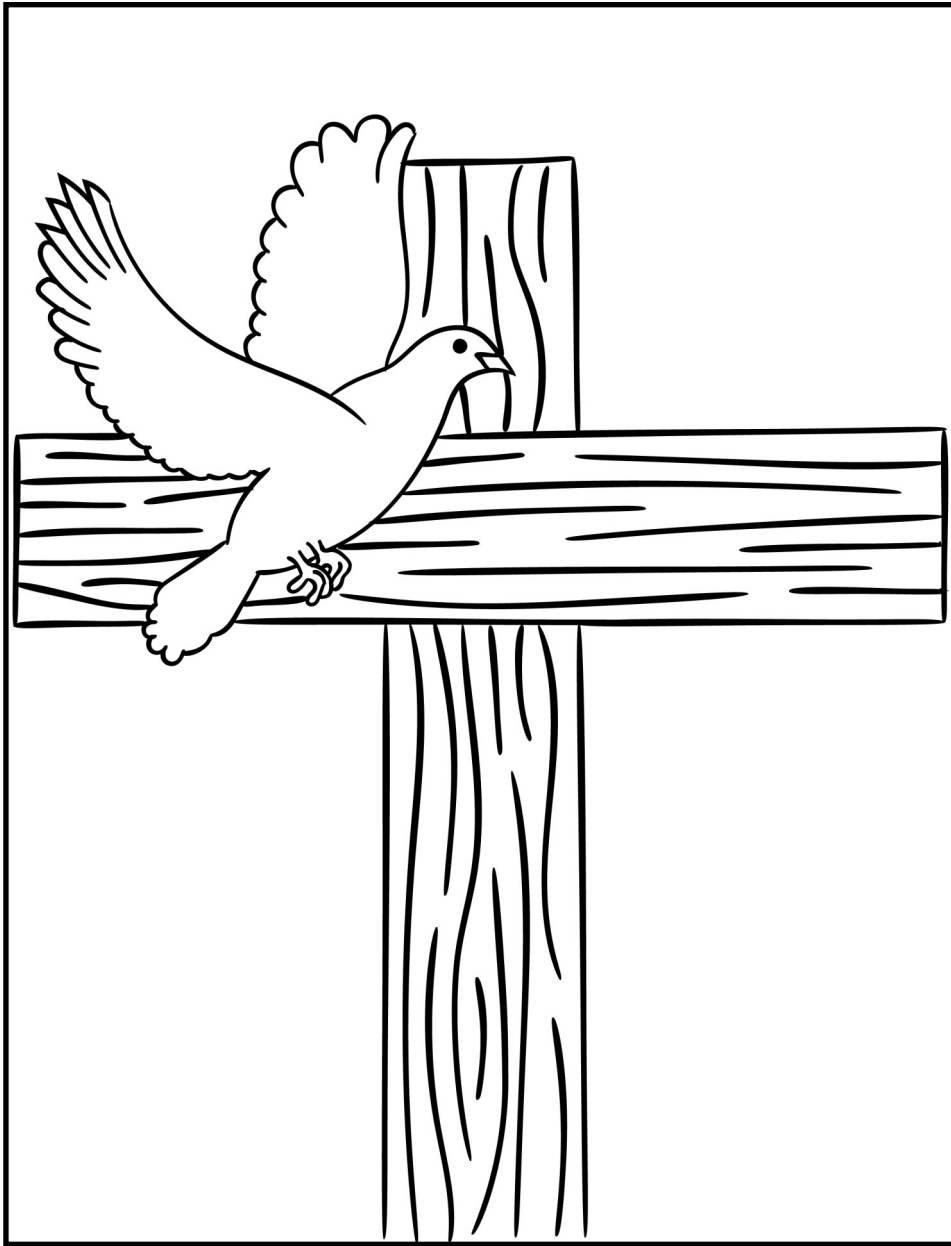
When Jesus rose to heaven
