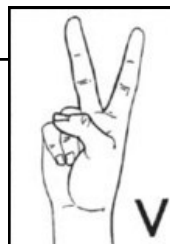

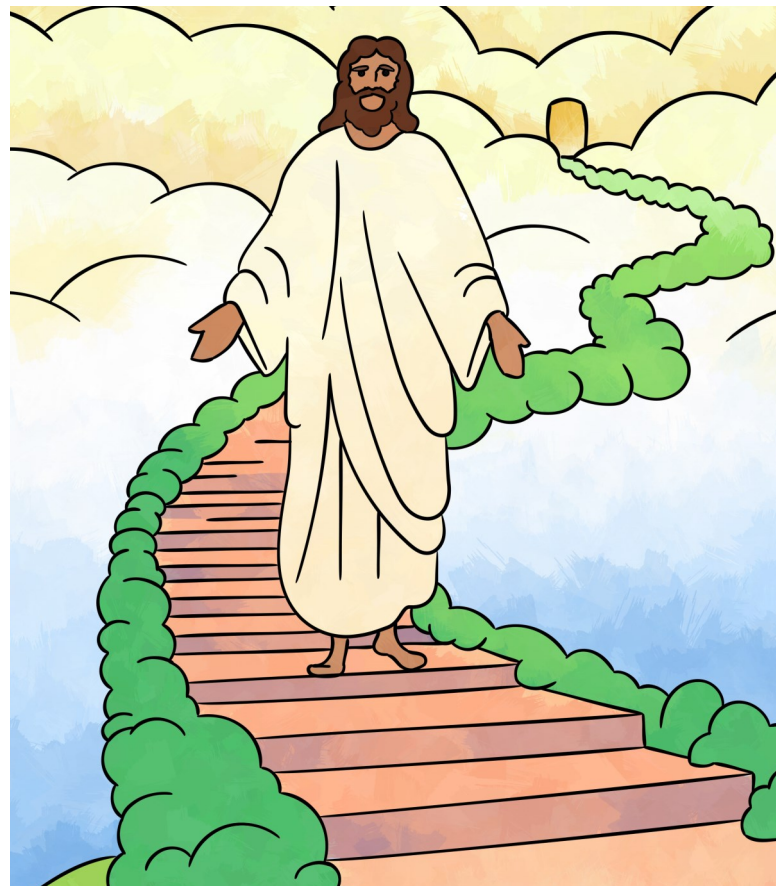

Us from sin did save



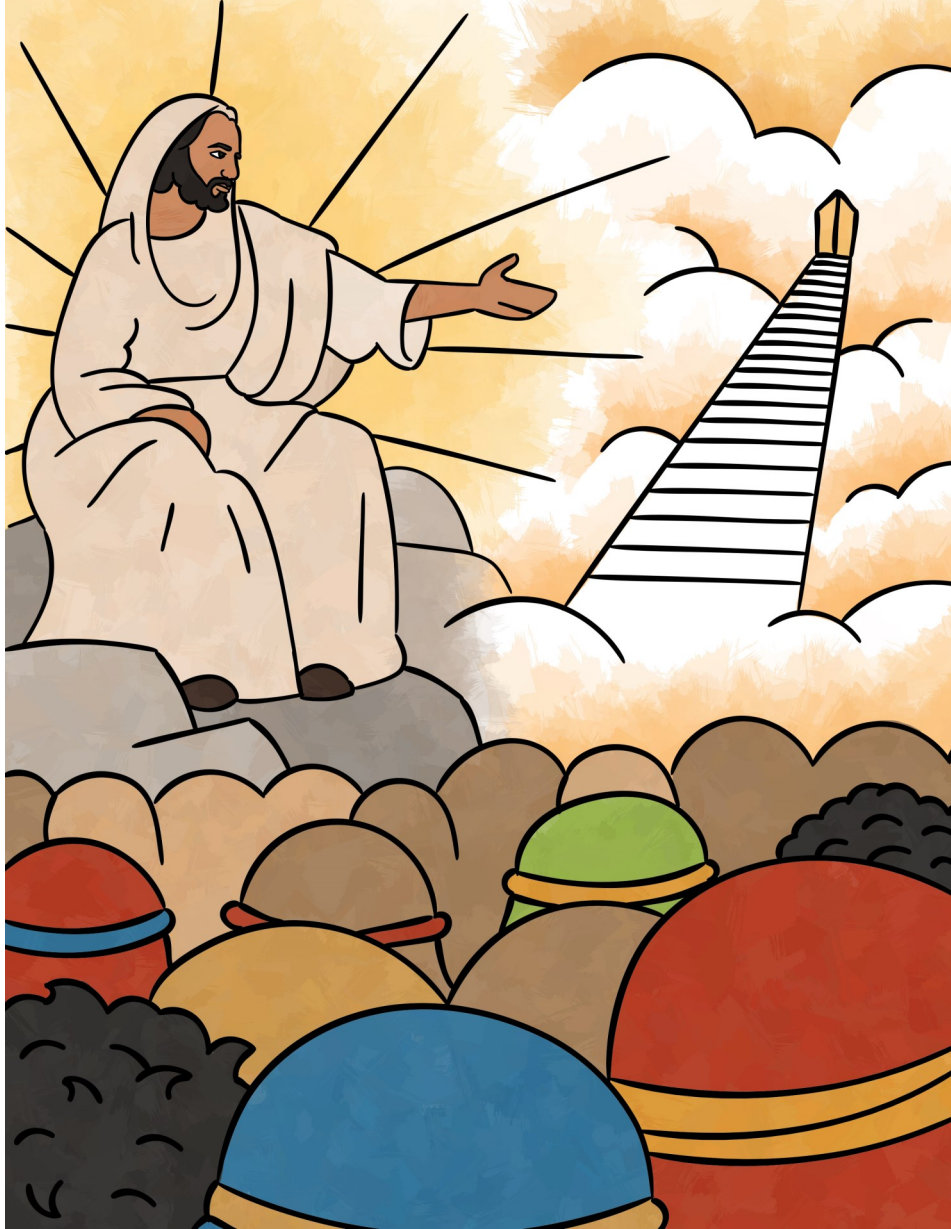
When Jesus died upon the cross;
