Booklet Introduction: Hold up a Bible.

<u>What is this? What is in the Bible?</u> The Bible tells us about Jesus and other people, some of whom obeyed God and some who disobeyed him. It tells us about who God is and what he has done. It tells about the creation of the earth and all that is in it. The Bible also tells us what God says is good for us to do.

<u>Why should we read the Bible?</u> If we don't read the Bible we won't learn the things that God says are important for us to know. If we know what God wants and do what he wants, then our lives will go be better and God will be pleased with us.

The Bible teaches us about history, the things people did long ago. From those stories we learn how we should live and follow God. We learn what happens when people choose to disobey God and do what's wrong. We learn what happens to people when they love and follow God.

<u>Day 3</u>: What do we learn from examining God's creation? What do we learn from studying God's commands? What does it mean to submit? Why should we submit to God?

Day 4: What will we do we do if we love God? Why do we have to think about God's truth?

Day 5: Where do our actions come from? What do we have to hold on to in order to do what is right? Why?

<u>Day 6</u>: What is God's truth in us like? What does it mean to bear fruit? What is the fruit we bear?


