#### PICTURES NEEDED

9-3 Apple tree

#### NURSERY CONCEPT

The fruit shows the kind of tree.

#### LESSON CONTENT

Show the visual. (Picture 9-3)

What is this a picture of? When God created plants, he made all different kinds of plants to grow. You look at a plant and see what type of fruit it produces. The fruit that a plant has will tell you the type of plant.

Just as you know that a tree is an apple tree because it has apples, you can know if a person is good or bad by the things he or she does. If a person does good things that means he is growing good fruit. A person who does bad things grows bad fruit.

#### QUESTIONS

Where did plants come from? How do you know what type of tree something is? How do you know what a person is like? What are good things people do? What are bad things people do?

## PRAYER

Pray that you would produce good fruit by doing good things to others.

## BIG QUESTION

**What does the fruit of a tree reveal?**

Fruit shows whether a tree is good or bad.
