## Lesson Passage—Genesis 9:18-29

<sup>18</sup>Now the sons of Noah who went out of the ark were Shem, Ham, and Japheth. And Ham was the father of Canaan. <sup>19</sup>These three were the sons of Noah, and from these the whole earth was populated.

<sup>20</sup>And Noah began to be a farmer, and he planted a vineyard. <sup>21</sup>Then he drank of the wine and was drunk, and became uncovered in his tent. <sup>22</sup>And Ham, the father of Canaan, saw the nakedness of his father, and told his two brothers outside. <sup>23</sup>But Shem and Japheth took a garment, laid it on both their shoulders, and went backward and covered the nakedness of their father. Their faces were turned away, and they did not see their father's nakedness.

<sup>24</sup>So Noah awoke from his wine, and knew what his younger son had done to him. <sup>25</sup>Then he said: "Cursed be Canaan; A servant of servants He shall be to his brethren."

<sup>26</sup>And he said: "Blessed be the LORD, The God of Shem, And may Canaan be his servant. <sup>27</sup>May God enlarge Japheth, And may he dwell in the tents of Shem; And may Canaan be his servant."

<sup>28</sup>And Noah lived after the flood three hundred and fifty years. <sup>29</sup>So all the days of Noah were nine hundred and fifty years; and he died.

## Daily Reading Questions

Day 1: What are parents to do for their children? Why are they to do that? How should children treat their parents? What does it mean to honor?

Day 2: What are parents to teach their children? What are God's laws? What are God's deeds? What are needs we have? What is our greatest need? Why is that our greatest need?

Day 3: What happens when children honor their parents? Why? What should you do to your parents? Why?

Day 4: What will happen when you obey your parents? Why? What does it mean to be rebellious? What happens when you are rebellious?

Day 5: Why are parents wiser than children? Why should you obey your parents the first time they tell you to do something?

Day 6: What should you thank God for? What should you thank your parents for? Why? What will make your parents happy? Why?

## Concluding Lesson

Review: What are parents to do for their children? Why are they to do that? How should children treat their parents? What does it mean to honor? Why are parents wiser than children? Why should you obey your parents the first time they tell you to do something?

Prayer: Thank God for the parents he has given you. Pray that you would want to obey and honor them as you should. Pray that you would obey and honor God as you should.

Application: Discuss ways that you are obedient to your parents and ways that you are disobedient. What is the difference in the outcomes when you obey or disobey your parents?

Thinking It Through: Have the child write or dictate what important truth was learned from the lesson, how he/she can apply that truth, and a prayer to God.

## Day 1 Draw a picture of your family.

God gives children parents  
to help them learn and grow.  
Honor to their parents  
children are to show.  
Parents train their children  
to submit to God above  
So their children follow God  
and experience his love.

What does the verse mean?

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Ephesians 6:4: <sup>4</sup> And you, fathers, do not provoke your children to wrath, but bring them up in the training and admonition of the Lord.

## Day 6 Draw a picture of your house and family.

Thank God for your family  
and the home where you do live.  
Be sure to thank your parents  
for all that they do give.  
And make your parents happy  
by choosing to do right.  
Obeying their instructions  
and walking in God's light.

What does the verse mean?

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Proverbs 4:20-22: <sup>20</sup> My son, give attention to my words; Incline your ear to my sayings. <sup>21</sup> Do not let them depart from your eyes; Keep them in the midst of your heart; <sup>22</sup> For they *are* life to those who find them, And health to all their flesh.

## Day 5

Draw a picture of a treasure chest.

Parents are much wiser.  
They know what's right and good.  
So follow what they say  
and act the way you should.  
Be sure to obey them,  
the first time you are told.  
Honoring them brings treasure  
more valuable than gold.

What does the verse mean?

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Proverbs 4:7-8: <sup>7</sup> Wisdom *is* the principal thing; *Therefore* get wisdom. And in all your getting, get understanding. <sup>8</sup> Exalt her, and she will promote you; She will bring you honor, when you embrace her.

## Day 2

Draw a picture of you listening to your parents.

God commands the parents  
to teach his laws and deeds.  
As children put their trust in God,  
he will meet their needs.  
Our greatest need is to love God  
and follow in his way.  
And children learn to do this  
as their parents they obey.

What does the verse mean?

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Psalms 78:4-5: <sup>4</sup> We will not hide *them* from their children, Telling to the generation to come the praises of the LORD, And His strength and His wonderful works that He has done. <sup>5</sup> For He established a testimony in Jacob, And appointed a law in Israel, Which He commanded our fathers, That they should make them known to their children.

**Day 3** Draw a picture of your family playing together.

When children honor parents,  
life goes really well.  
Cause when we do what's right,  
God with us will dwell.  
So remember to do good  
and your parents to obey.  
Submit to them and honor them  
each and every day.

What does the verse mean?
